
The MYP is a 3D curriculum framework that fosters the development and mastery of skills, concepts, and knowledge. The MYP framework is organized as follows:

- **Related Concepts (RC):** These concepts are subject-specific and allow subjects to add depth to the learning process. Related concepts are deeply related to the knowledge that is specific to each subject group.
