4. More themed activities for children to take part in and to cooperate

- 2 Group activities that include all students to develop team work ability, making the school a big family
- 3 Nutrition and food safety. Less oil, salt, more vegetable; Can the lunch supplier Qi Lin Hotel ensure the food safety?
